QUALIFICATIONS: 50 point scale

1. Boulder Prep graduate – prerequisite
2. Completed senior portfolio, including application to at least three universities (5 pts)
3. Completed 500-1000 word essay describing the impact the service learning program has had on your perspective on the privilege of education (10 pts)
4. Complete 500-750 word essay describing how if you receive this scholarship you will "pay it forward". (15 pts)
5. Provide statement and proof of application for two other scholarships. (10 pts)
6. ACT Improvement. (at least two ACTs while at BPHS, 2 pts for every point of improvement for a max of 5 ACT points, or 10 scholarship points)

AWARDS:

1. Minimum: \$1,000
2. Minimum: 10 scholarships available
